## 3 ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PARISH COUNCIL FOR THE YEAR 2020/2021

The Chairman gave a verbal report on the activities of the Parish Council over the previous year. He thanked the Parish Councillors and Borough and County Councillors that had helped over the last 12 months.

The Council had installed a new roundabout on the play area at Stanley Village Recreation Ground to match that installed at Stanley common Recreation Ground the previous year. It had also worked with a local volunteer group to establish a wildflower area at Stanley on the recreation ground. The Changing Rooms roof at Stanley Common had now been replaced and, subject to a few more minor works, the Council was looking forward to welcoming football teams back in the new season.

The Chairman noted the death of former Chairman Mike Cheetham MBE and confirmed that the bench to be installed on Park Avenue would bear a memorial plaque in his honour.

The Chairman thanked parishioners that had volunteered for the speedwatch scheme.

Looking ahead the Council was considering ways to remember the passing of Prince Philip and doing something in his memory.

The meeting noted the precept set by the Parish Council at £18,342.45 for 2021-22.
